

Primary Caries Prevention Intervention

Document fluoride varnish application every 6 months up to 4th birthday and then annually to 21st birthday if fluoride varnish is applied.

Meaningful Use (MU – eCQM 074) - Patients from birth to 21st birthday.



Oral Health Screening – Clinical Support

SCREENING:

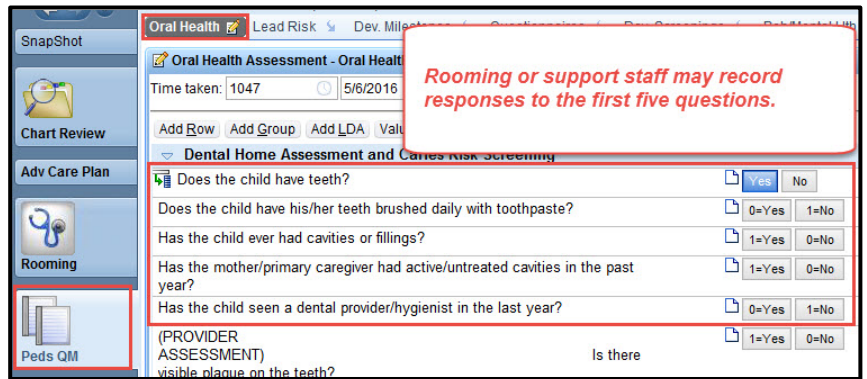
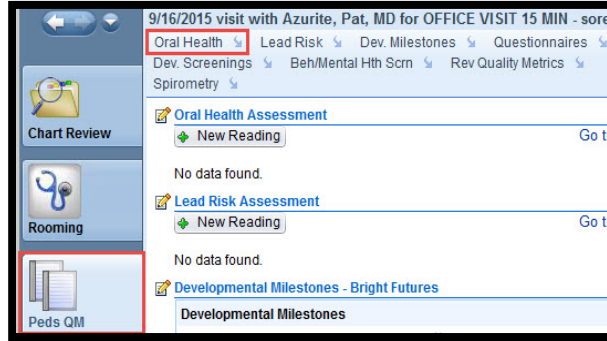
Step 1: Go to **Peds QM** activity and select the **Oral Health** section.

Step 2: Click **Yes** or **No** button to indicate whether the child has teeth. Additional questions will appear when response is 'Yes'.

Step 3: Record responses for the next four questions only.

Step 4: If the child has seen a dental provider/hygienist **in the last year, go to the Health Maintenance** activity and follow the steps outlined below in **Document a Fluoride Varnish Done Previously or Elsewhere**.

The remaining questions must be completed by the provider when fluoride will be administered.



P Oral Health Assessment – Provider

After clinical staff has recorded responses for the first four oral health assessment questions, complete the remaining questions if administering fluoride:

Step 1: Select the **Peds QM** activity.

Step 2: Click the blue arrow to scroll to the Oral Health section.

Step 3: Click the date/time stamp to resume the assessment begun by clinical support.

Step 4: Complete the three **Provider Assessment** questions.

The system calculates a Risk Assessment score based on the responses.

Step 3: If the calculated score is zero, **click the Low Risk Assessment result button**. If the score is 1 or greater, **click the High/Moderate Risk button**.

Step 4: Click a response to indicate whether fluoride was applied or if the patient refused.

P Document Fluoride Varnish Application without Oral Assessment– Provider

For children age 6 or greater, you can also use the **Oral Health** section in the navigator to document fluoride varnish without an oral assessment by clicking the Applied fluoride varnish button.

C Document a Fluoride Varnish Done Previously or Elsewhere (i.e. Dentist) - Clinical

Step 1: Go to the Health Maintenance activity.

Step 2: Select 'Fluoride Varnish' and click Override button.
