Oral health is key to overall health and well-being during pregnancy. While the Affordable Care Act (ACA) has improved health care coverage for pregnant women broadly, limitations in benefits, access and education continue to keep many women from receiving important dental services. Co-presented by the Association of Maternal and Child Health Programs (AMCHP) and the National Institute for Health Care Management Foundation (NIHCM), with support from the Maternal and Child Health Bureau, this webinar will explore ways to connect women to dental coverage during pregnancy, with special attention given to Title V national performance measure (NPM) 13a: percent of women who had a dental visit during pregnancy.

After participating in this webinar, attendees will be able to:

- Understand and articulate the importance of dental care during pregnancy;
- Implement programs to educate pregnant women about the importance of dental care;
- Replicate strategies in other states to increase the number of women receiving dental care during pregnancy; and
